

Expected Accomplishments / Indicators of achievement / Main activities and timeline

We give for **free** services of medical doctors/specialists (SMD) to both those without quality medical cover (Tom, say) and to those with quality medical cover¹ (Mary, say) in the following 3 steps:

Step 1 whenever Tom/Mary is sick,:

(i) s/he on her/his phone/computer² asks for SMD HERE and interaction between a doctor/specialist and Tom/Mary helps to determine what course of action to take for Tom's/Mary's medical treatment;

(ii) if **Referral** is necessary, we buy medical cover for Tom³;

(iii) if **Test** is necessary, the doctor/specialist requests Tom/Mary to get test/s done at their nearest test facility, after we approve testing quotation (for Tom), which the facility shares HERE;

(iv) if **Prescription**⁴ is necessary, the doctor/specialist prescribes medicine⁵ and Tom/Mary get/s the medicine from the nearest pharmacy, after we approve medicine quotation (for Tom), which the pharmacy shares HERE;

(v) if Tom/Mary wants to generate stipend for him-/her-self, Tom/Mary:

(A) urges sick people to get the SMD through his/her (Tom/Mary) phone/computer; and,

(B) nominates the village (that contains the people) for Reusable Sanitary Towels, Toilets and Rainwater Harvesting (RaHa) System⁶, and

Tom/Mary do activities in Step 3 below while we continue to give the SMD⁷, Reusable Sanitary Towels⁸, Toilets⁹ and or RaHa Systems¹⁰ to the nominees.

Step 2

We continue to generate demand for the SMD by informing members of public (MOP) via off-line & on-line news media about latest supporters and beneficiaries of this project (including about Tom/Mary), See report about previous beneficiaries¹¹.

Step 3

In response to Steps 1 & 2 above, MOP, including students, nurses, pharmacies and Community Health Workers help people in getting the SMD while they (MOP) nominate villages/schools for Toilets, Reusable Sanitary Towels and RaHa System and or point (add points) for those that have already been nominated.

A typical person/primary healthcare facility/pharmacy/Community Health Worker asks us for SMD whenever they have a sick person, and other cycles start in Step 1 above.

NOTE 1: THOSE WITH QUALITY MEDICAL COVERS (twqmc)

Twqmc are our main supporters.

The SMD are fast therefore, whenever 9 people without medical cover are asking for SMD around the time one of twqmc is getting the SMD, the person (one of twqmc) enables us to give the SMD to the 9 and, since 81% of consultations with our doctors/specialists involve no further medical interventions, twqmc that get the SMD may help us claim for their (twqmc) SMD from their respective insurers, which (insurers) are expected to experience >10% reduction in the value of claims thanks to twqmc.

NOTE 2:

If in Kenya, for example, we start paying for Tom's SHIF membership so that he may start getting inpatient services.

NOTE 3: WHAT IF THERE IS NO PHONE/COMPUTER

Whenever Tom/Mary is sick but has no phone/computer, s/he walks to a pharmacy/primary healthcare facility (PHCF)/Community Health Workers (CHWs) and:

(a) the pharmacy/PHCF/CHW on behalf of Tom/Mary asks for SMD HERE then the pharmacy/PHCF/CHW helps Tom/Mary make **Prescription** Request; and,

(b) step 1 ii - iv above follow. Step 1 v also follows but for the pharmacy/PHCF/CHW (to generate more revenue).

NOTE 6: NOMINATION

Each nomination for Towels, Toilets or RaHa Systems is done jointly by, at least, four (4) people that have each helped 10 people to get SMD.

In other words: a person must persuade at least 3 others, preferably Community Health Workers (CHWs), to help households get the SMD — every time the person and 3 CHWs help a total of 40 people, the person and the 3 CHWs earn one chance of jointly nominating the villages or schools (that contain the 40 people) for Reusable Sanitary Towels, RaHa System or Toilets,

and if they nominate for:

(a) the towels, the person and the **3 CHWs each gets a to be agreed stipend** for gathering girls in the village(s), chatting about, and firmly committing to reuse sanitary towels that the villagers then get from us through the person/CHWs — the stipend is per service to a to be agreed number of girls / ladies;

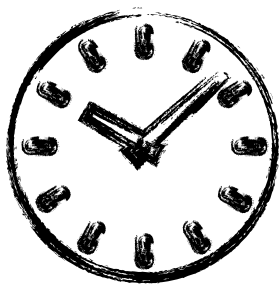
(b) the toilets, the person and the **3 CHWs each gets a to be agreed stipend** for mobilising villagers for cleaning the toilets that the village gets from us through the person/CHWs — the stipend is per a to be agreed number of days spent on the cleaning; and,

(c) the RaHa system, the person and the **3 CHWs each gets a to be agreed stipend** for mobilising villagers for cleaning the rainwater harvesting systems that the village gets from us through the person/CHWs — the stipend is per a to be agreed number of days spent on the cleaning.

NOTE 8: REUSABLE SANITARY TOWELS

Reusable Sanitary Towels that are antimicrobial (intelligent towels), luxurious, soft and stretchy. They are easy to manage (30 minute soaking, rinsing, squeezing and drying). They dry fast.

Each of the towels can withstand at least 100 washes (assuming that a towel is washed twice in a period, 100 washes translate into 4 years of use).

The antimicrobial efficacy does not deplete over time as the treatment is permanently bonded to the towels.





NOTE 9: TOILETS

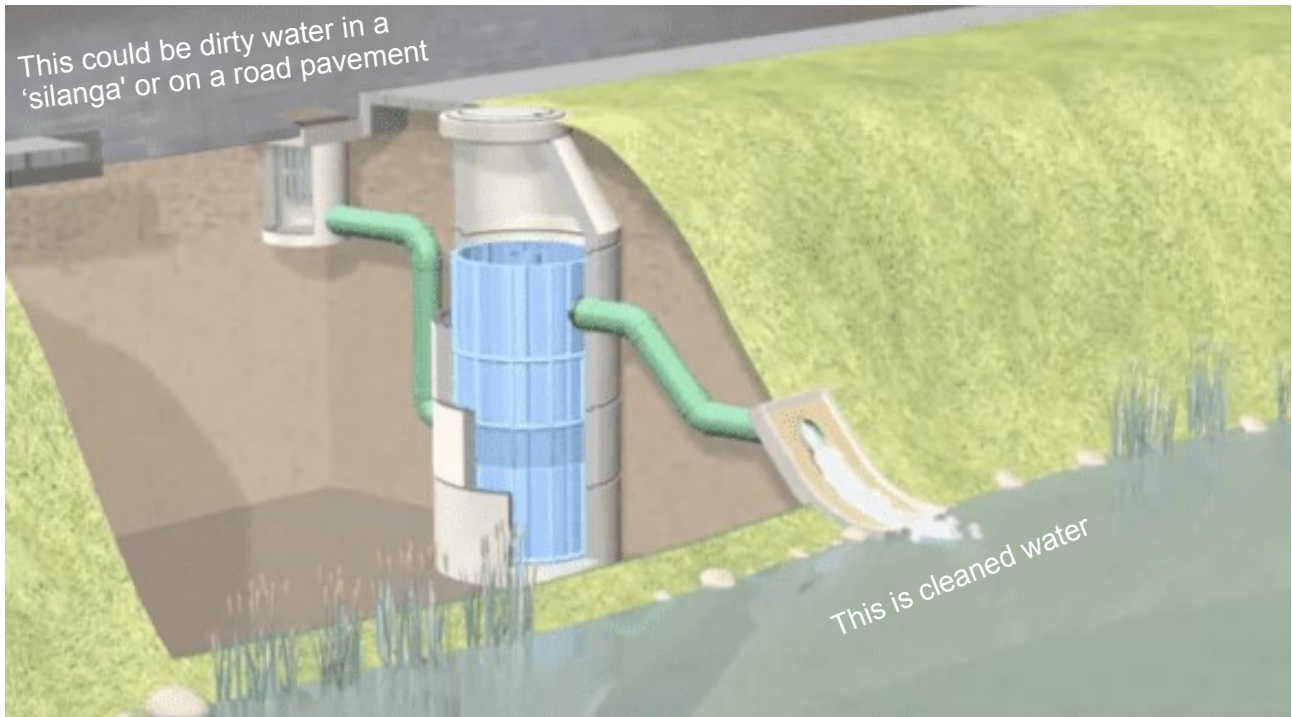
We always believe that rainwater should be protected from pollution. It's our goal to harvest and clean stormwater for the water starved -- this starts with providing toilets upstream.

With permission from roads authorities and such, we want to build toilets besides roads, especially at common police check points.

NOTE 10: RAINWATER HARVESTING (RAHA) SYSTEMS

Water that is: of maximum capacity; as near to the consumer as possible; and, as clean as can be made possible by the best available technology -- even where we have to provide boreholes, we find boreholes:

- with enough volume (we give 3 year water source capacity guarantee per borehole);
- with the highest quality water (that competes with bottled mineral water); and,
- precisely in the piece of land where the consumer needs it.



NOTE 11:

This (demand generation) contains information for ensuring that the SMD, towels, toilets and RaHa System are free of charge e.g. that “The Sick Don’t Pay Mary/Tom/pharmacy/primary healthcare facility (PHCF)/CHW, accelerateUHC pays Mary/Tom/pharmacy/PHCF/CHW”.
